



Course Title: EXCAVATION / TRENCHING COMPETENT PERSON

Location: On-site (at customers' location)

Course Description:

This training program is intended for individuals designated as the Competent Person during excavation and trenching activities, which may include managers, Supervisors, lead workers or equipment operators. It provides a fundamental understanding of excavation and trenching standards for the Competent Person, and exceeds State and Federal training requirements. Participants receive a proprietary student workbook. Customers receive class rosters and course evaluations.

- Understand tabulated data and tables for using shoring systems.
